Installation Instructions

STEP 1

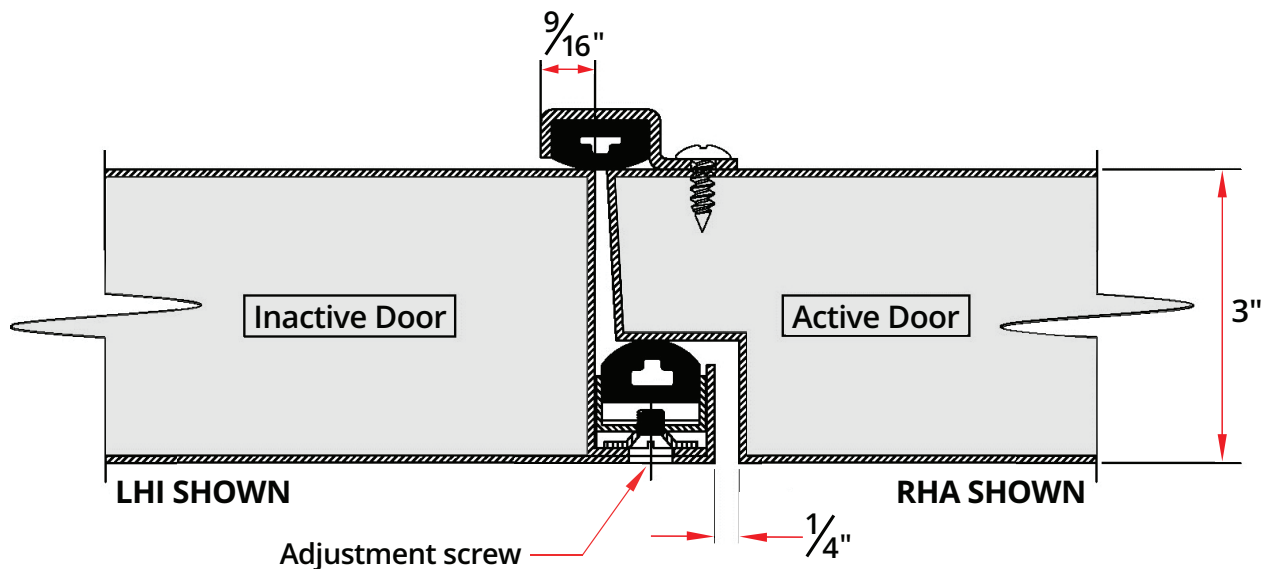
- The neoprene seal that runs the entire length of the door is cut long at the factory and must be trimmed accordingly.
- Cut $\frac{1}{8}$ " past the retainer on the top and contact the threshold on the bottom.

STEP 2

- The applied astragal mounts onto the active door and runs the entire length of the door.
- The neoprene should extend each side by $\frac{1}{8}$ " to ensure a tight fit.

STEP 3

- To adjust the applied astragal inward you can shim behind the mounting screws as needed.
